System 4 (Frets 12-17):
12, -H (1-2-0), 1, 0, H (2-0-4), 2, H (4-0-4), 2, H (4-0-4), -Po (2-0), 1, -H (2-0), 1, 0, 2

System 5 (Frets 15-20):
15, 0, 0, 0, -Po (0-0), 0, 0, 0, -Po (1-2-0), 1, 0, H (2-0-4), Po (2-0), 4, 0, -Po (2-5), H (0-2), H (0-4), 2, 0, 4, repeat
